

ORDINANCE 61

**AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE MANAGEMENT, PROTECTION, AND OPERATION OF
THE WATERWORKS SYSTEM OF THE VILLAGE OF BIRD ISLAND, MINNESOTA, AND
AMENDING SECTION I OF ORDINANCE 44**

The Village Council of the Village of Bird Island, Renville County, Minnesota, do ordain as follows:

That Section I of Ordinance #44, be amended to read as follows:

“That from and after the passage and publication of this Ordinance, and beginning June 1, 1941, all water rentals shall be paid on a meter basis and in the following amounts, to-wit: \$0.60 per thousand gallons for the first 5000 gallons and \$0.50 per thousand gallons for the excess over 5000 gallons and up to 10,000 gallons, \$0.20 per thousand gallons for the excess over 10,000 gallons. Provided, however, that the water rental and charge for the users of water shall be the sum of Two Dollars (\$2.00) per quarter.”
